The form is confidential but must be available if a participant has an accident or illness while on a trip. If any changes in health condition or contact persons have occurred within the 12 months, be sure to update this form.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE OSHER LIFELONG LEARNING INSTITUTE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN. If membership has lapsed, be sure to include payment for current year membership: \$20/year for August-August membership; \$10 for December-August membership. All memberships expire each August.
